

## **MAJOR GENERAL PETER JAMES BOYLAN (PHS 1954)**

MG Peter J Boylan graduated from West Point Military Academy in 1961 and began military life as a second lieutenant with the 24<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division in Europe. From there, MG Boylan served in Vietnam until 1973 where he attained the rank of major in 1968 and lieutenant colonel in 1969. When MG Boylan returned to the United States, he earned the rank brigadier general in 1984 and major general in 1988. Other positions held by MG Boylan include being the commandant of cadets at West Point and the deputy inspector general of the secretary of the Army. MG Boylan is now retired from the Army and currently holds the position of president of Georgia Military College.
